off the A625 - where Ecclesall Road South becomes Hathersage Road

latitude longitude coordinates 53.3415° N, 1.5398° W

distance from Sheffield City Centre 4.2 miles (7.1 km)

at the side of the Limb Brook

near Dore village

near the Peak District National Park

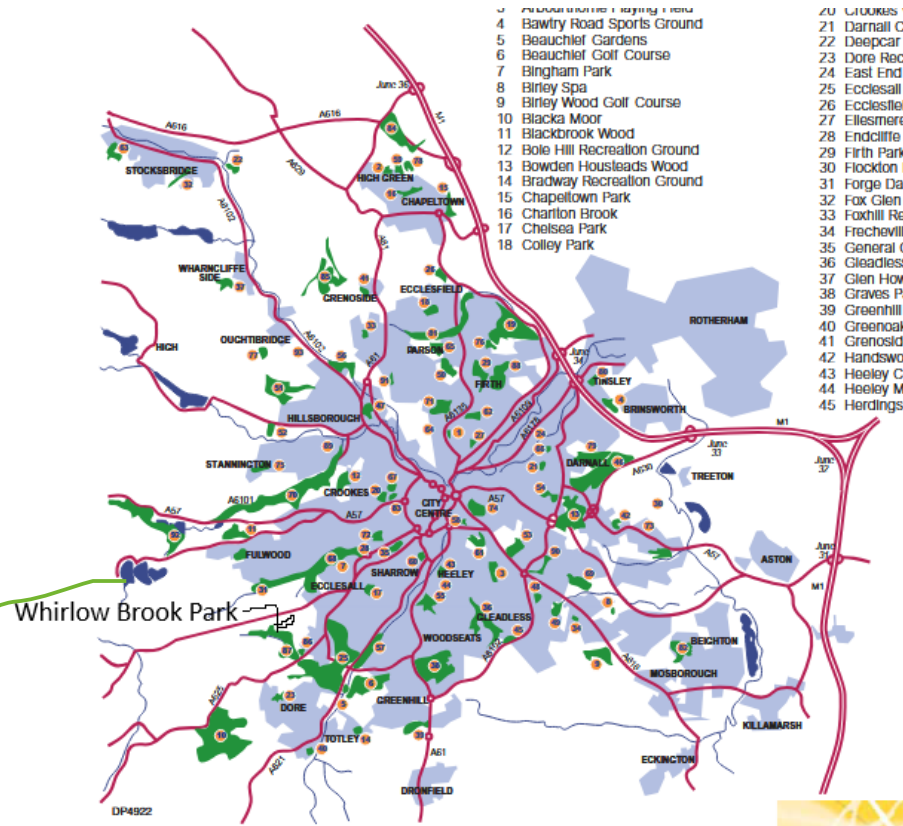

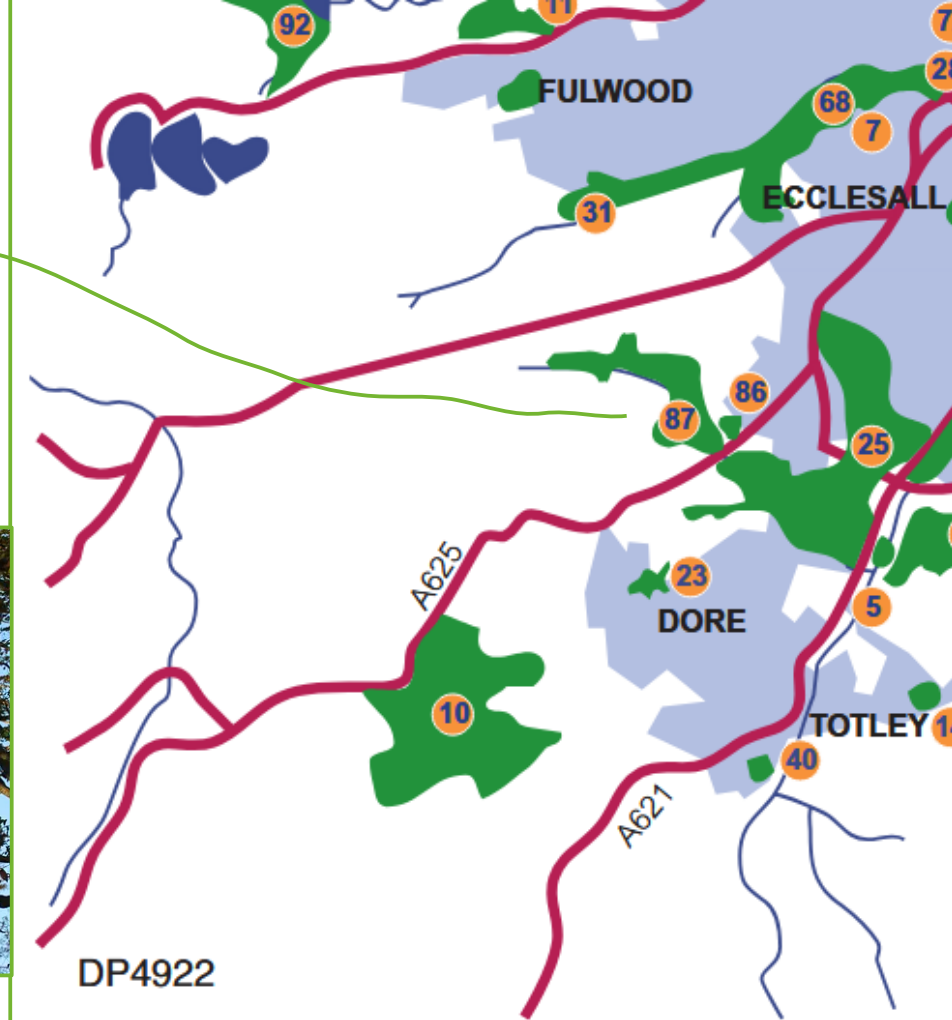


Parks and Green Spaces

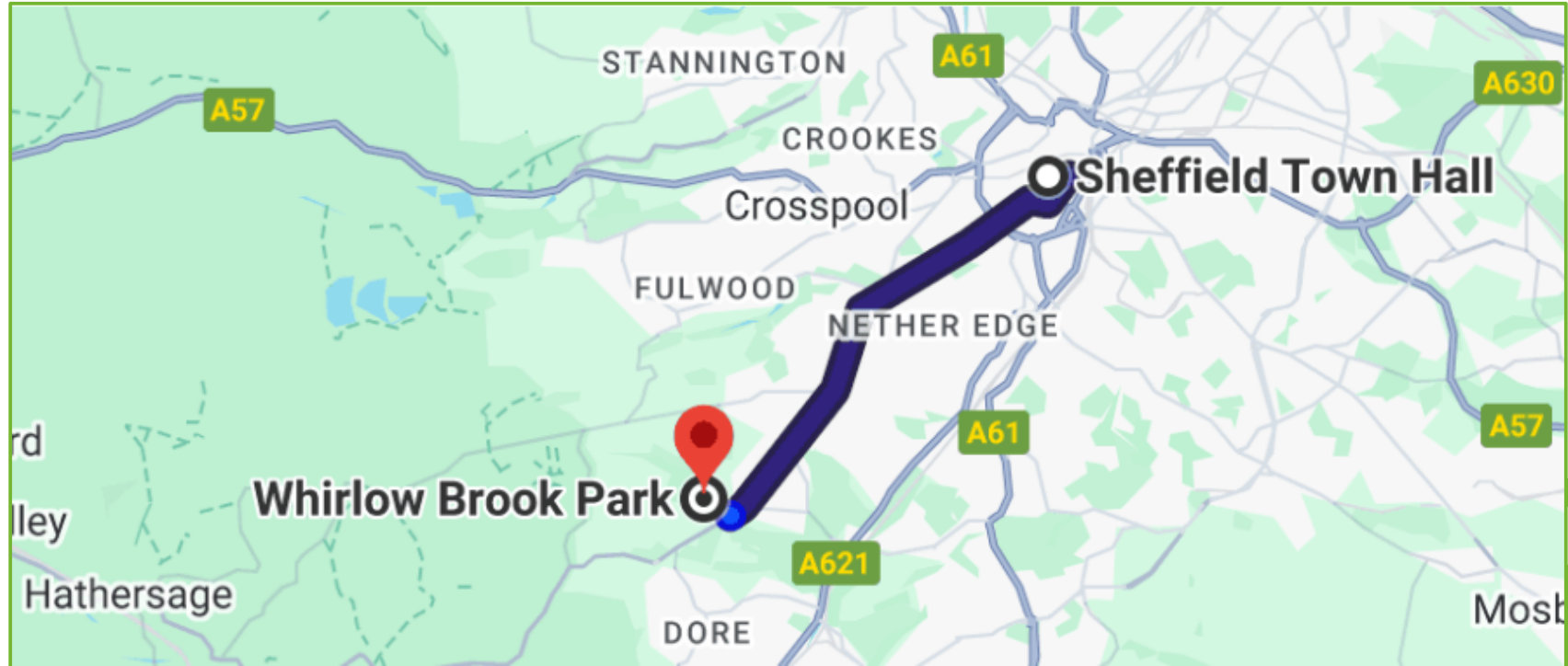
Trains stopping at Dore & Totley station

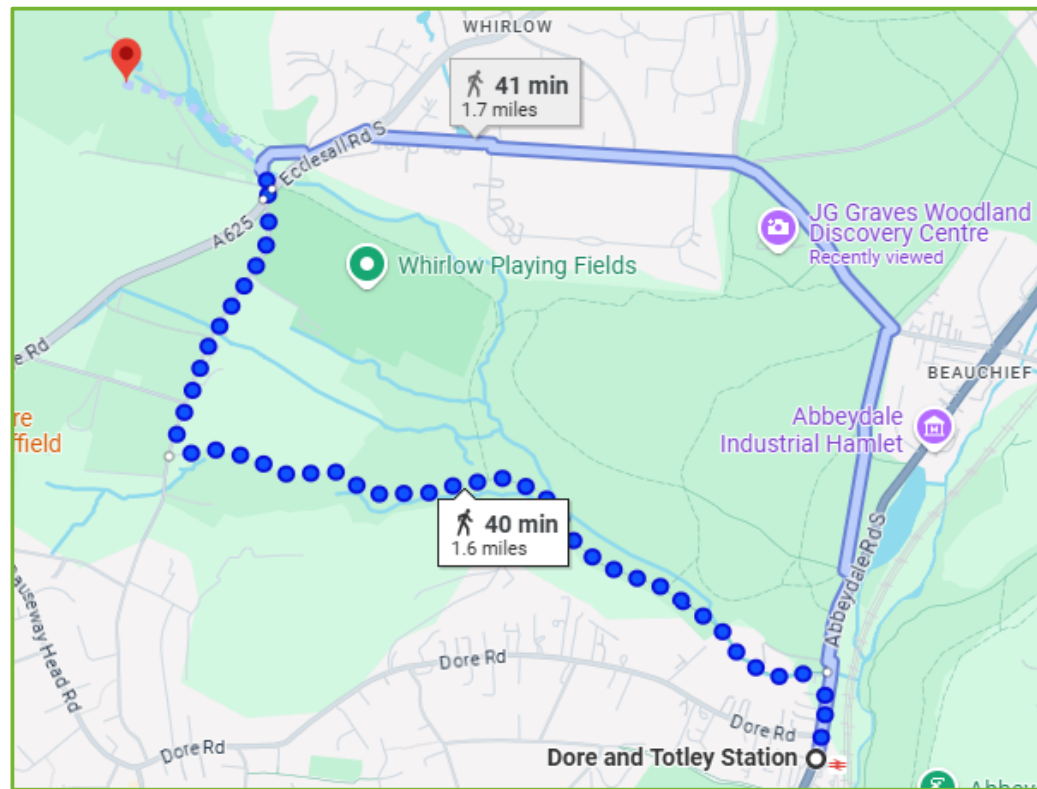
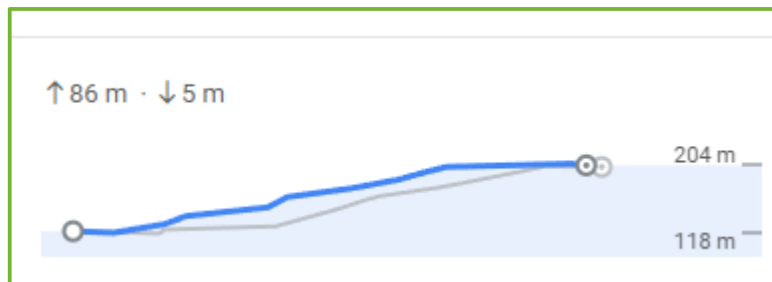

According to Google maps it takes about the same time to go by road or through the woods to get to Whirlow Brook Park. It's uphill all the way!

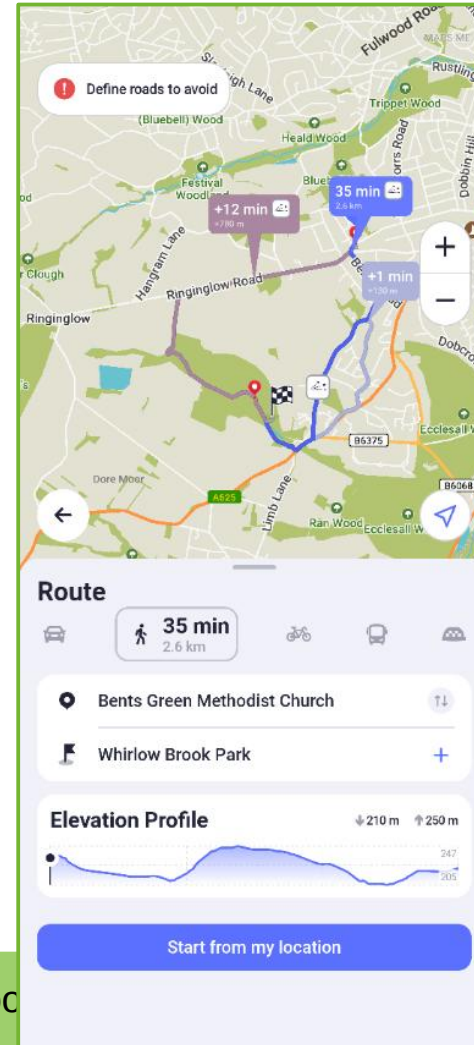
